Environmental Policy

Broadridge Financial Solutions, Inc. (“Broadridge,” the “Company” or “we”) recognizes the importance of reducing our emissions and other environmental impacts. Broadridge focuses on the following practices and principles to support sustainable business and long-term growth.

Governance

The Company’s Board of Directors (the “Board”) and the Governance and Nominating Committee of the Board oversee Broadridge’s ongoing commitment to environmental matters as part of their oversight of sustainability-related matters of the Company. Our Sustainability Committee, a cross-functional executive committee of the Company (the “Sustainability Committee”), reports regularly to the Governance and Nominating Committee and annually to the Board on sustainability-related initiatives and strategy.

Climate Strategy and Risk and Opportunity Assessment

- Measure and analyze Scope 1, 2, and material Scope 3 greenhouse gas (“GHG”) emissions in line with existing frameworks;
- Develop and track net zero GHG emissions reduction targets and implement decarbonization strategies ; and
- Assess and manage material climate-related risks and opportunities associated with our business.

Clients, Vendors and Associates

- Focus on digitization and providing eco-friendly services and products to our clients;
- Engage with and encourage our vendors to be accountable to environmental management principles through our Vendor Code of Conduct to help mitigate our environmental footprint throughout our supply chain; and
- Foster a company culture that promotes peer-led environmental education and awareness and opportunities to participate in environmental activities through initiatives such as BeGreen, our environmental associate network.

Compliance and Climate Reporting and Disclosure

- Exercise transparency through environmental reporting, including an annual Sustainability Report;

- Hold ourselves accountable at the applicable environmental, safety and protection standards;
- Operate in compliance with all applicable U.S. Environmental Protection Agency-mandated environmental reporting requirements at our production facilities; and
- Monitor emerging environmental rules and regulations.
